

RESOLUTION ON REINSTATEMENT OF TEXAS IMPACT FUNDING

Adopted by the Annual Assembly of the Texas Conference of Churches
February 17, 2004

Whereas Texas Impact provides essential services of education and advocacy to the Texas faith community;

Whereas Texas Impact is an effective and efficient organization with excellent leadership and staff;

Whereas the Texas Conference of Churches and Texas Impact have a 30 year history of mutual concerns and effective action as is detailed in a recent letter from Linda B. Team, President of Texas Impact Board of Directors and attached for reference herewith; ([link to letter of Linda B. Team](#))

Whereas the drastic budget cuts in Texas have caused distress for children and adults, so that witness of our biblical mandates to care for those made vulnerable in society is needed more than ever to reach the ears and hearts of our legislators; therefore be it

Resolved that the Texas Conference of Churches reinstate some level of funding to Texas Impact within the constraints of budget to protect and affirm the long-standing relationship with its ecumenical partner.

***UPDATE:** The Board of Directors of Texas Conference of Churches, at its October 7, 2004 meeting, voted to reinstate funding to Texas Impact to affirm the long-standing relationship. The amount of funding will be determined annually through the budget evaluation process.*
